Dear students, participants of the field mycology course "From Fungal Morphology to Genotype 2023",

The field course is approaching, and below we are delivering to you the second series of practical information before we meet online.

All important information and materials regarding the field part of the course will be shared there. Danish students should note that further information is given at the course homepage at Absalon.

The list of things you should bring with you is also there. Please, remember that as this is a border zone you should have your **IDs** with you. It is also good to have your European Health Insurance Card (just in case). As you already know, we will ask you to contribute 10 euro/day to a joint food pool. However, as euro is not a currency used in Poland, the best will be if you bring just 270 PLN in cash. To let us know about your food preferences complete a short survey [link] by August 21st.

Concerning transportation, note that there is a regular Czech public bus line 390 (000554 5) from Náchod to Karłów at 1:10 p.m. (via Kudowa-Zdrój). If you miss it, you can use private buses (e.g. TomBusKudowa, the cost is ca. 120 PLN/8 pers., it can be booked by phone +48-793975353 or email tombustaxi@gmail.com).

We also remind you that the first course-related workshop will take place on Friday, August 25th at 10 a.m. CET. It will focus on the use of molecular data for fungal identification and simple phylogenetic analyses, as well as on the PlutoF data management system. The workshop will be organized in a hybrid form. Hence, we recommend that you join the local on-site meetings. All local meetings will be connected online to share common lectures and exercises. Students from Heidelberg and Frankfurt and those, who cannot join local onsite meetings can always join directly on-line. The link to the online Zoom Meeting:

Before the workshop, please create a personal PlutoF account. It can be registered here: https://app.plutof.ut.ee/register and install the PlutofGO app on your phone (links are on the course webpage). In addition, we recommend you to install the "Svampeatlas" app, which provides a state-of-the art picture recognition system, even if you are not registered as an user (The function: Navneforslag).

The meeting on the August 25th will be also a good chance to answer all your last questions about the field trip itself.
